Dear Chancellor Fox,

I am writing this letter of recommendation for Professor Leeka Kheifets, currently a Professor In-Residence in the Department of Epidemiology of the School of Public Health at UCLA.

Dr. Kheifets brings over 25 years of experience in research. She is highly regarded by experts in many disciplines, and especially in the field of epidemiology where she has made numerous important contributions. This is exemplified by an extensive publication record in the peer-reviewed literature.
