All first aid kits used at UCSD shall have, as a minimum, the items listed below. This list is meant to meet at least the minimal standards per ANSI Z308.1-2009; personnel working in each location may supplement their kits according to their own individual requirements. Where special hazards are present (e.g., hydrofluoric acid, organophosphates, cyanides, etc.) additional items may be necessary. Contact EH&S for further information.

For serious or life threatening injury or illness, call 911.
Report any injury to your supervisor.


MINIMUM REQUIREMENT:

<u>Item</u>	<u>Quantity</u>
Absorbent Compress, 32 sq in with no side smaller than 4 in.	1
Adhesive bandages, 1" x 3"	16
Adhesive Tape, 3/8" x 2.5 - 5 yd. total	1
Antiseptic, 0.5g (0.14 fl oz) applications	10
Antibiotic treatment (topical), 0.5g (0.14fl oz)	6
Burn treatment, 0.5 g 90.14 fl oz) applications	6
Medical Exam gloves	2 pair
Sterile pads, 3"x3"	4
Triangular bandage, 40"x40"x56"	1
First Aid Guide	1

OPTIONAL (These additional items are included in the First Aid Kits provided and maintained by EH&S):

Bandage Compress, 4"x4"	1
CPR Microshield	1
Insect Sting wipes	10
Eye Wash – 1 fl oz.	1
Cold Pack	1
Scissors/Forceps	1 each
Assorted adhesive bandages (fingertip, knuckle)	8 each

Please note that department representatives are responsible to check first aid kit inventory periodically and replace used or expired items. For EHS-provided kits, contact EHS for restocking.
