Pest Control Request

EH&S PEST MANAGEMENT PREPARATION LIST

ALL INDOOR PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS:

1. **All INDIVIDUALS WITH SENSITIVE HEALTH CONDITIONS**, e.g. allergies, respiratory ailments, or pregnancies, are advised to follow their physician's advice and to vacate the premises for a minimum of eight hours.
2. All persons and indoor pets must stay out of the treatment area during and following the pesticide application. Reentry is safe after the spray has dried and the room is ventilated. This will be a minimum of two to three hours. Reentry time will be posted on door. Upon reentry there may be a **temporary** slight odor.
3. All food items, coffee cups and eating utensils must be removed from the room or placed in containers with tight-fitting lids. Cover all toys and stuffed animals.

GENERAL PEST APPLICATIONS: (In addition to the first paragraph)

1. Infested areas must be free of all articles prior to a pesticide application. This includes all cupboards, cabinets and drawers. Place dishes, pots & pans, glassware, foodstuffs, canned goods, silverware, towels, medicines, etc., on a table in another room and cover with a sheet. **Remove all kitchen cabinet drawers.** Pull objects away from baseboards. Open windows if possible.
2. Remove all trash and clean cupboards and shelves before treatment. After treatment, wipe down all kitchen counter tops with soap and water. Remember that most pest infestations are eliminated through improving sanitation.
3. The pest control technician may choose to use sprays, baits, dusts or any combinations thereof after determining the control strategy.

NOTE: For several days following the treatment, ant/roach activity may increase as the pesticide residue is encountered. For several weeks, small roaches or scattered ants or other pests may appear and then die from the pesticide residue.

FLEA APPLICATIONS: (In addition to the first paragraph)

1. Remove all items from the carpeted area before the scheduled treatment.
2. Thoroughly vacuum all carpets, especially along the baseboards, prior to and immediately following the treatment. Vacuum around and under sofa cushions and any place a pet or persons spends time. Remove vacuum bag and place it in a sealable plastic bag then discard. Sweep all uncarpeted floors.
3. Wash all bedding following the treatment. This includes pet bedding. Run items through a dryer cycle for a minimum of 20-30 minutes.
4. Cover aquariums, fish bowls and air filter intakes. Turn off air filter and they should remain off for 2 to 3 hours following treatment.

NOTE: For heavy infestations, it may take several days for the treatment residue to eliminate all fleas.

ALL OUTDOORS PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS:

EXTERIOR TREATMENTS:

1. Exterior pesticide treatments are limited to the perimeters/patios and walkways of buildings. Please remove all personal items (especially toys) from the area of infestation. Be sure to inspect inside and remove any potted plants that are infested.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE AREA SCHEDULED FOR TREATMENT IS PREPARED ACCORDING TO THE INSTRUCTIONS LISTED ABOVE OR THE TREATMENT WILL BE POSTPONED.

THE REQUESTING INDIVIDUAL MUST MAKE ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR ACCESSING AND SECURING THE BUILDING.

Residents agree to follow all applicable preparation instructions listed above. After receiving this form, the Housing Office will contact EH&S to schedule a treatment date. For cancellations, residents must give the Housing Office 24 hours notice in advance. Failure to properly prepare for treatment or to follow cancellation procedure may result in a \$20.00 fine being issued by the Housing Office.

It is the responsibility of the Requesting Individual to convey this information to all persons likely to enter or occupy the treated area during or immediately following a pesticide application (California Code of Regulations, Section 3094 [b]).

I hereby authorize a representative of UCSD Environment, Health & Safety to conduct inspections/treatment as found necessary to control the pest problems specified below.
